The Illinois Human Rights Act prohibits discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of housing on the basis of

- Race/Ancestry
- National origin
- Sex
- Religion
- Disability
- Familial status
- Sexual orientation
- Gender-related identity
- Military status
- Arrest record
- Source of income
- Immigration status
- And more



Anyone who feels they have been discriminated against in housing may file a complaint **within one year** of the discrimination with the Illinois Department of Human Rights.



The Human Rights Act Applies to:

Landlords, rental managers, property owners, real estate agents, bankers, developers, builders, appraisers, and all others engaged in real estate transactions.
